

## Email setup on an iPhone

**Go to: Setting - Mail, Contacts, Calendars - Add Account - Other**

**It asks for the following:**

Name: Mail Setup  
Address: mailsetup@whitedoggreenfrog.com  
Password: mypw  
Description: mailsetup@whitedoggreenfrog.com

*Click Save*

Switch from IMAP to POP (do this by touching the POP icon, POP should be highlighted in blue)

**Incoming** and **Outgoing mail servers** are the same: mail.yourdomain.com. For example:

### **Incoming Mail Server:**

Host Name: mail.whitedoggreenfrog.com  
User Name: mailsetup@ whitedoggreenfrog.com (your full email address)  
Password: mypw

### **Outgoing Mail Server**

Host Name: mail.whitedoggreenfrog.com  
User Name: mailsetup@whitedoggreenfrog.com  
Password: mypw

*Click Save.*

It may say *Cannot Connect Using SSL*, if it does, select *Yes*.

You will get a pop up prompt saying "*Server Connection Failed - The certificate for mailsetup@whitedoggreenfrog.com may not be valid.*" Just ignore it and select *Continue*.

You will probably end up at the main *Mail, Contacts, Calendar* screen. Select the newly created account (mailsetup@whitedoggreenfrog.com).

Scroll to the bottom of the page and select *SMTP* under *Outgoing Server*. Select mail.whitedoggreenfrog.com. Turn off *SSL* if it is on and change the *Server Port* to 26.

Click on *Authentication*, *SSL* should be *OFF*, *Authentication* should be *Password* and *Server Port* should be *110*.
